ADVANCED PLACEMENT SCHOLAR AWARDS

Each year, the College Board sends us notification of students who performed exceptionally well on the end-of-year Advanced Placement exams.

There are three top honors: AP Scholar, AP Scholar with Honor, and AP Scholar with Distinction.

Students who achieved scores of 3 or higher on 3 or more AP exams earn the designation of **AP Scholar**. 28 Middlesex students, 5 of whom graduated in May, earned this distinction for 2016.

33 Middlesex students earned the distinction of **AP Scholar with Honor** by virtue of achieving an average score of 3.25 or higher on all AP exams taken, and grades of 3 or higher on four or more AP exams. 21 of these students are still at Middlesex.

ACADEMIC HONORS AWARDS
