Head Coach, Junior Varsity Girls' Squash**

Middlesex School seeks a qualified squash coach for the JV Girls' Squash team in the winter of 2018-19. Middlesex is a coeducational college-preparatory boarding secondary school of 400 students located in Concord, Massachusetts. The JV Girls' Squash Coach will be responsible for planning and implementing practice sessions with a roster of roughly 10-12 girls from grades 9-12, and managing the team on match days-- both home and away--in a highly professional manner. The team will normally practice four times per week on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday afternoons--either from 3:30 to 5:00 or 5:00 to 6:30—and play matches twice per week (usually on Wednesdays and Saturdays). The season will run from 11/14/2018 to 2/23/2019, with a varying 6-day schedule and Sundays off; the team will not practice from November 17-26 or from December 11- January 6.

Ideal candidates will have previous coaching experience and/or high level playing experience, as well as the ability to coordinate, communicate, teach the game, and foster a positive and supportive team culture with a focus on player development. They will also be organized, dependable/punctual, strong communicators, and actively maintain a positive environment that is appropriate and safe- physically, psychologically, and emotionally- for all involved. The JV Head Coach will work with one Middlesex faculty assistant coach, and will coordinate closely with the head coach of the Varsity team to monitor player development throughout the season.

This is a part-time seasonal position, and a competitive salary will be commensurate to qualifications and experience. A Bachelor's degree is preferred.
