Assistant Coach, Alpine Skiing**

Middlesex School seeks a highly qualified Assistant Coach for the Girls' and Boys' Alpine Ski programs for the winter season of 2022-23. Middlesex is a coeducational college-preparatory boarding secondary school of 400 students located in Concord, Massachusetts. The Alpine Ski Assistant Coach will be responsible for supporting the Head Coach in all aspects of the program, have Alpine skiing experience with both Slalom and Giant Slalom techniques, assist with dry land and on-snow ski training, assist with ski prep and waxing (previous experience helpful but not necessary), and attend all daily practices and competitions.

Seasonal practices will run from the week after Thanksgiving through the first week in March. Practices are usually held on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday, and Saturday from roughly 3:30-5:30pm, with competition days on Wednesdays and, occasionally, Fridays. Some Saturdays will be off days according to the school schedule and Sundays are always off days. There is a two-week break for winter holidays where there is no formal practice held. The team often holds an overnight ski training trip just prior to the return of classes in early January to be held in New England, and plans are snow dependent.

Ideal candidates should have an outgoing and enthusiastic coaching persona, enjoy working with the high school age population and demonstrate a willingness to learn new coaching and training techniques. They will also be comfortable modeling the philosophies and values associated with the program, building positive relationships with a roster of roughly 30 girls and boys from grades 9-12, and supporting with race-day management in a professional manner. They will also be organized, dependable, punctual, strong communicators, and actively maintain a positive environment that is appropriate and safe- physically, psychologically, and emotionally- for all involved.

This is a part-time seasonal position, and a competitive salary will be commensurate to qualifications and experience. A Bachelor's degree and a U.S. Ski & Snowboard Alpine Level 100 Coach Certification are preferred.
