Middlesex School seeks a qualified Assistant Coach for the Girls' Junior Varsity Crew team for the spring season of 2023. Middlesex is a coeducational college-preparatory boarding secondary school of 400 students located in Concord, Massachusetts. The Girls' JV Crew Assistant Coach will be responsible for supporting the Girls' Varsity and Junior Varsity Crew Head Coaches in all aspects of the program, while primarily focusing on the development of novice rowers at the on-campus boathouse on Bateman Pond. Program-specific duties include coaching athletes in all aspects of the sport of Crew, maintaining a safe and positive atmosphere for the Crew athletes, modeling the philosophies and values associated with the program, building positive relationships with athletes from grades 9-12, and supporting with race-day management, both home and away, in a professional manner. The JV Girls' Crew Assistant Coach will support the head coach with planning and executing team practices and helping to coach at all home and away races.

The team will practice four or five times per week in the afternoon and compete on Wednesdays and/or Saturdays against other ISL and New England Prep schools. The Crew season generally runs from late March to late May, with a varying 6-day schedule and Sundays off.

This is a part-time seasonal position, and a competitive salary will be commensurate to qualifications and experience. It is important to note that all Middlesex employees in the 2022-23 school year will be required to submit proof of a full COVID vaccination, via Employee Navigator, prior to beginning their work on campus.
